The December Meeting of the Dodge County Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman David Frohling at 6:00 p.m.

The Board rose to say the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken with all Supervisors being in attendance with the exception of Supervisors Conway, Macheel, Maly, Priesgen, and Yaroch.

Chairman Frohling called for approval of the minutes. A motion was made by Supervisor Steger and seconded by Supervisor Guckenberger to approve the minutes of the November 12, 2025, meeting of the County Board, as recorded. A motion to approve the minutes carried by voice vote.

**Special Order of Business: 4-H Key Awards**
